

## Les Enfants Sauvages "Cool Moon" 2016

## In the vineyard

Soil: Clay and limestone Vine age: 2 plots of 80 years old / 2 plots of 10 years old Yields: 15HL/ha Vineyard size: 1.5 ha

## In the cellar

Yeast: Indigenous Fermentation Vessel: Foudre Aging: In foudre (10 months) Filtration: Light before bottling Fining: Never Sulfites: 30 mg total Alcohol: 13.00% Production: 300 cases

**Note:** "Cool Moon" comes from a blend of 4 vineyards. All four grape varieties are cofermented in 2 oak foudres for the entire cuvee.



30% Grenache Gris, 30% Grenache Blanc, 20% Maccabeu, 20% Vermentino

- Direct press
- The juice goes in foudre without any must settling. Fermentation takes place on the gross lees
- A first racking takes place after malo is complete
- Then the wine goes back to the same foudre (cleaned) and will age for 10 months
- The two foudres will be blended in a bigger tank and will stay there 1 month to be homogenized
- Finally, bottling with a light filtration and 2mg of sulfites added
