NOTE: "Groseille" comes from the Tourgine AOP but is declassified as VDF to avoid administrative and AOP regulations. 6 parcels total: 4 parcels come from Saint-Aignan and 2 parcels from Montlouis-sur-Loire. All parcels are comprised of clay and limestone, with some silt in Saint-Aignan.



## **100% GAMAY**

- Harvested by hand in small cases
- 3/4 direct press and 1/4 whole cluster maceration for 3 weeks without any punch down nor pump over
- Long fermentation of 6 months on fine lees, undergoes malo
- 8 months of aging (including the 6 months of fermentation)
- Bottling around mid-May with 1g/HL of sulfites added
