

## François Ducrot Saint-So 2019

Note: Saint-So is sourced from a single organic farm located in Aspiran, a 45 minute drive west of Montpellier. The winemaker, François Ducrot, vinifies his wine in the cellar of Domaine Enclos de La Croix. The vineyards themselves are situated in a poor, shallow silt and clay soil on limestone bedrock. This means the yields are small but that results in a unique concentration from the typically light varietal.



## 100% Cinsault

- Harvested early in the morning to keep the berries cold
- Grapes are 100% de-stemmed
- Slow fermentation in stainless steel tank with some pump over
- Racking and pressing when fermentation is complete
- 6 months of aging in stainless steel tank
- Bottling with 1g/HL of sulfites added and a light filtration
