80% Grenache, 10% Syrah, 8% Mourvèdre, 2% Cinsault, Counoise, Picpoul, Muscardin

- Hand-harvesting with attentive sorting
- Whole cluster maceration in concrete tank (3 weeks)
- Racking and vertical pressing after fermentation
- 22 months of aging 8 months in foudre and 14 months in concrete tank
- Bottled in July 2017 without any filtration nor fining
- Rested for 8 months in the cellar
