

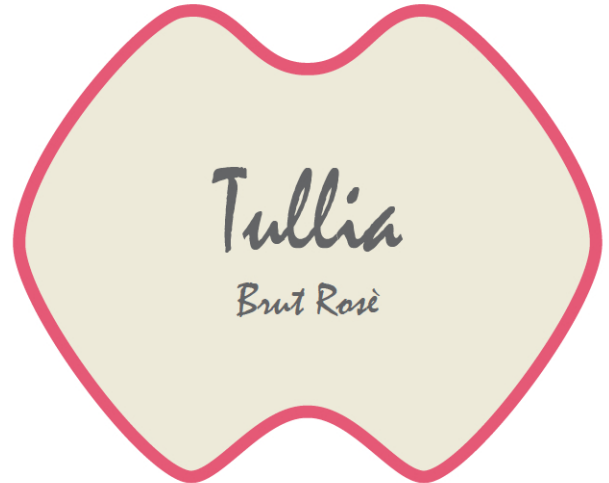
## TULLIA

The S. Osvaldo winery is located in Loncon di Annone Veneto, in the province of Venice, on the border with Treviso and Friuli-Venezia Giulia, one of the most suitable areas of Veneto for vine-growing. On this land, the worldwide famous Lison-Pramaggiore DOC wines are produced.



Founded in the 1930's, by the Hungarian Baron Lajos Babos, S. Osvaldo was taken over by Armando Serena in 2004. The descendant of a dynasty that's been engaged in the wine sector since the late 19<sup>th</sup> century, Serena put S. Osvaldo on the map as one of Italy's main wine producers.
