

BULL RUN DISTILLERY

Lee Medoff began his career as a brewer, then moved on to winemaking where he first became exposed to distillation. He started House Spirits Distillery in 2004, and was one of the founding members and first president of the Oregon Distillers Guild, America's first craft distillers guild. In 2010, with his sights set on making a pure malt Oregon Whiskey, he started Bull Run Distillery. It is here that he focuses on creating dark, aged spirits, from rum made with Hawaiian cane sugar to many expressions of whiskey.



Before Bull Run became a distillery, they were tracking down barrels of whiskey and settling themselves up as merchant bottlers. From these travels came Bull Run Straight Bourbon Whiskey which started as a small one-off project but quickly became the anchor of the Merchant Bottling Expressions. Bull Run's Straight Bourbon Whiskey is selected from a stock of four year old whiskey before getting proofed down with water from Bull Run Reservoir and bottled.

BULL RUN STRAIGHT BOURBON WHISKEY



Base Ingredient/Mash: More than 60% corn, more than 20% rye, and less than 10% malted barley purchase from Great Western Malting

Still Size & Type: 700 gallon steel column still

Distillation: Distilled to approximately 72.5% ABV

Maturation: Aged for four years in new American oak

Cooperage: Char #3 New American Oak from Kelvin Cooperage

Filtration: Chill filtered

Finishing: Proofed with water from Bull Run Reservoir

Alcohol: 44%

Country: USA

Region: Oregon

Sub Region: Portland

Spirit Style: Bourbon
