

BULL RUN DISTILLERY

Lee Medoff began his career as a brewer, then moved on to winemaking where he first became exposed to distillation. He started House Spirits Distillery in 2004, and was one of the founding members and first president of the Oregon Distillers Guild, America's first craft distillers guild. In 2010, with his sights set on making a pure malt Oregon Whiskey, he started Bull Run Distillery. It is here that he focuses on creating dark, aged spirits, from rum made with Hawaiian cane sugar to many expressions of whiskey.



Bull Run Distillery began with the goal of making a truly Whiskey. A whiskey that would reflect the place where it is made and the influences that guided its vision.

Their goal was to create nothing less than a new style of American Whiskey. The Oregon Single Malt Whiskey is made from 100% malted barley from the Klamath Basin and brought up in new American oak barrels influenced through the years by Western Oregon's four distinct seasons. This whiskey is the culmination of the combination of grain, wood, time and Portland.

BULL RUN SINGLE MALT WHISKEY



Base Ingredient/Mash: 100% malted barley from Klamath Basin

Still Size & Type: 700 gallon steel column still

Fermentation: The wash is fermented using ale yeast, resulting in pronounced fruit esters

Distillation: Double distilled

Maturation: Aged for six years in new American oak

Filtration: Chill filtered

Finishing: Proofed with water from Bull Run Reservoir

Alcohol: 44.5%

Country: USA
