Scribe produces vibrant, terroir-driven wines in Sonoma California. The winery was founded by Andrew and Adam Mariani in 2007 on a site that was known for winemaking before Prohibition. The Mariani brothers are the fourth generation of California farmers, so they are inspired by their relationship with nature and ensure that every vineyard remains in harmony with the whole ecosystem of each site. The wines are vinified with a non-interventionist philosophy.



About the Rosé of Pinot Noir

“Northern California experienced another cool and wet winter which kept the vines dormant through late March/Early April. The springtime brought a mix of heat spells followed by cool and wet weather. Our initial predictions were for a later harvest, but the warm summer months hastened the growing cycle of the vines. Harvest started for us August 14th with the Rosé of Pinot Noir and ended with our Atlas West Cabernet Sauvignon in mid-October.”
