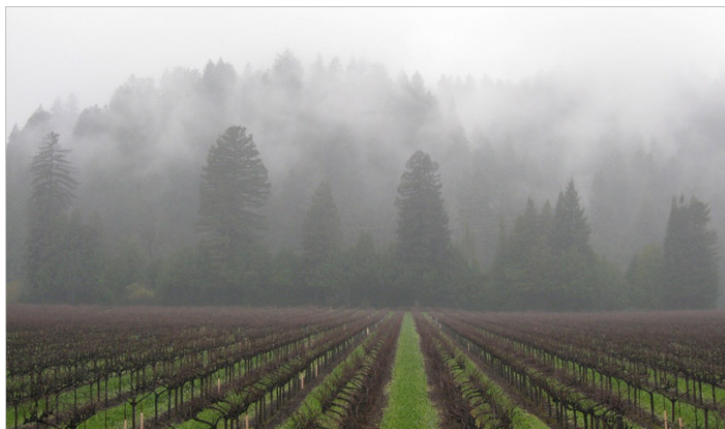


FOLK TREE

The concept of Folk Tree developed through conversations and connections with our winemakers and their vineyard partners. The moment when inspiration meets opportunity in wine and farming.

Our vision is to produce a wine that represents the quality of our partners, our friends and our families.



We were inspired by our connections, influenced by our tastes. We were also focused on looking forward to the “village wines” of American culture: wines that inspire, wines that we can all afford.

This is 100% Pinot Noir. The wine was aged 7 months in 100% French Oak (20% new). The wine exhibits light berry, spice, subtle earthy notes, and signs of French Oak.

Folk Tree is a unique expression of some of the most coveted vineyard sites in Arroyo Grande Valley.

"On the nose, primary aromas of earth and fresh cranberry, herbs and mint give way to sun dried apricot. A complex palate begins with light ripe raspberries, cherries and bright red fruit. A long finish is accentuated with subtle hints of black pepper."
