His goal is to produce articulate wines of "personality and character" from a broad range of sites around California, with an emphasis on the balance of elegance and power.



CITRINE CHARDONNAY



Varietal/Blend: 100% Chardonnay

Farming Practices: organic

Soil: (Rorrick Vineyard) limestone and clay / (Haynes Vineyard) volcanic ash and stone / (Heron Lake Vineyard) white quartz stones

Yeast: natural

Year Vines Were Planted: majority planted in 1974

Maturation: 12 months in oak; 7 of 8 barrels were 3rd use French oak; Haynes Chardonnay into 1 new barrel

Alcohol: 12.5%

Production #s: 8 barrels

6 barrels of Rorick Family Vineyard (45 year old own-rooted Wente Clone) Chardonnay vines planted to a base of limestone and clay in Calaveras County, one barrel of Haynes vineyard Chardonnay planted to Volcanic ash and stone and one barrel of Heron Lake Vineyard to add complexity and depth to this classic California blended Chardonnay.
