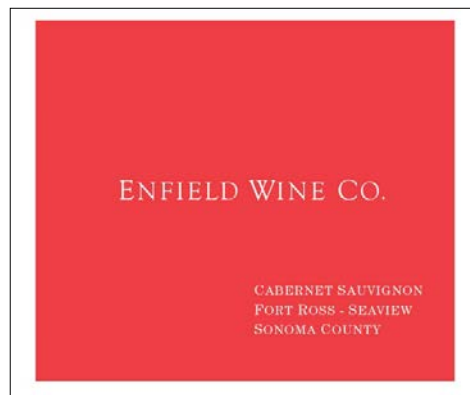
John Lockwood: Heron Lake Vineyard, Wild Horse Valley, 2013

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

"FORT ROSS - SEAVIEW"



Varietal/Blend: 80% Cabernet Sauvignon / 10% Merlot / 7.5% Cabernet Franc / 2.5% Petit Verdot (by acreage)

Farming: organic farming / spray twice a year / watered once a year and progressing to dry farming

Soil: medium-depth, mixed loam and volcanic soils

Ave Year Vines Planted: 1999

Harvest Technique: (everything is done) by hand

Fermentation: partially de-stemmed into an open-top fermenter / gentle punch-downs and foot treading 1 to 2 times a day

Aging: 2 years in French oak (1 of the 8 barrels was new)

Alcohol: 13.7%

Yeast: indigenous

Fined: none

Filtered: none

Production #s: 8 barrels

Winemaker Notes: A unique cool climate wine that reflects a classic era of California Cabernet. The dragon forces have aligned. We dialed back the whole cluster on the 2013 and it gave us a more precise wine. Rich but gentle, plush and powerful at only 13.7% alcohol, with acidity that will keep it fresh for extended aging. This wine reflects a classic period in California Cabernet. It will certainly reward patience, but is also explosively aromatic and exuberant right now.
