Firm, focused and dense, with blackberry, cherry, sandalwood and grilled rosemary flavors, coming together seamlessly on the long, vivid finish.

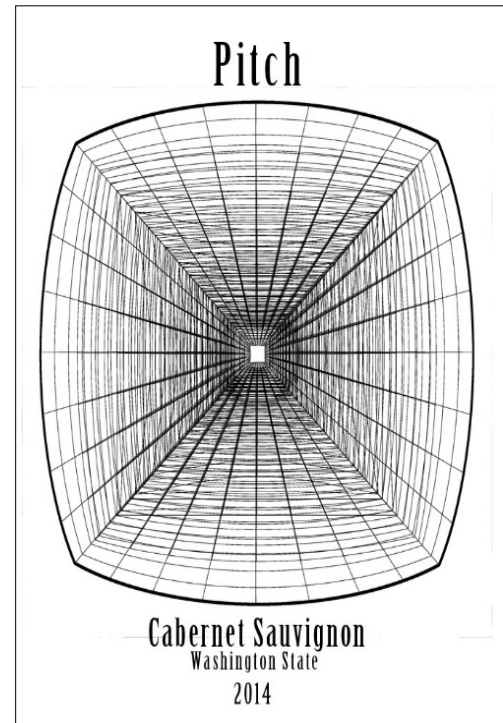

The 2014 vintage for Washington State was as close to ideal as possible.

Warm temperatures and an abundant, early crop produced picture-perfect grapes with soft tannins in the reds. With no rain, no early freezes and a harvest that was mostly done by late October (about two weeks ahead of usual), the vintage had no heat spikes and cool nighttime temperatures, leaving the acidity intact as well as rounding out the flavors and tannins.

Variety / Blend: Cabernet Sauvignon

Soil: clay and gravel

Vine Age: average age, 30 years

Fermentation: crushed gently and hand-punched and pressed directly to barrel where the wine finishes both primary and secondary fermentations.

Aging: 45% new oak with the remaining a mix of 3rd use French oak / the wine is aged for 14 months in the barrels
